"It's not about them, it's about somebody else," explained Neva Head, Facilitator at Jonesboro High School in Georgia. *Purpose* is the key word. Finding purpose in helping others is something Neva sees as a vital part of her students' passage into adulthood. "Chick-fil-A Leader Academy sparks a desire in their hearts to help others," says Neva of her students. "Teenagers want to have purpose — to be needed and to make a difference. We are planting seeds in these students for giving back." For their Do Good December project, Jonesboro High School partnered with Habitat for Humanity to paint a home in their community— not a small undertaking. For their Impact Project, they are collaborating with the Construction Department at the school to build a network of flowerbeds that they can place and plant at that same home in the spring.
